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Common License Types For Restaurants and Bars



Type 41 – Onsale Beer & Wine Eating Place

Issued to restaurants. Authorizes the sale of beer and wine for consumption on or off the premises where sold. Distilled spirits may not be on the premises (except brandy, rum, or liqueurs for use solely for cooking purposes). Must operate and maintain the licensed premises as a bona fide eating place. Must maintain suitable kitchen facilities and must make actual and substantial sales of meals for consumption on the premises. Minors are allowed on the premises. This license type is subject to Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) requirements and requires alcohol servers and managers of alcohol servers to be RBS certified.

Type 42 – Onsale Beer & Wine Public Premises

Issued to bars and taverns. Authorizes the sale of beer and wine for consumption on or off the premises where sold. No distilled spirits may be on the premises. Minors are not allowed to enter and remain (see BPC § 25663.5 for exception, musicians). Food service is not required. This license type is subject to Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) requirements and requires alcohol servers and managers of alcohol servers to be RBS certified.

Type 47 – Onsale General Eating Place

Issued to restaurants. Authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption on the licensed premises. Authorizes the sale of beer and wine for consumption off the licensed premises. Must operate and maintain the licensed premises as a bona fide eating place. Must maintain suitable kitchen facilities and must make actual and substantial sales of meals for consumption on the premises. Minors are allowed on the premises. This license type is subject to Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) requirements and requires alcohol servers and managers of alcohol servers to be RBS certified.

Type 48 – Onsale General Public Premises

Issued to bars and night clubs. Authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption on the premises where sold. Authorizes the sale of beer and wine for consumption off the premises where sold. Minors are not allowed to enter and remain (see BPC § 25663.5 for exception, musicians). Food service is not required. This license type is subject to Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) requirements and requires alcohol servers and managers of alcohol servers to be RBS certified.

Other License Types For Restaurants and Bars



Type 23 – Small Beer Manufacturer

Authorizes the production and sale of beer by breweries which produce fewer than 60,000 barrels per year. The privileges and limitations for this type of license are the same as for other beer manufacturers. This license formerly related only to Steam beer. “Steam” beer is made by fermentation at cellar temperature rather than near freezing as is the case with other beers. It is made using only one type of malt—malted barley.

“Micro-brewery“: A small-scale brewery operation that generally produces approximately 15,000 barrels a year. Its beer products are primarily intended for local and/or regional consumption. Typically, these operations are solely dedicated to the production of specialty beers, although some do have a restaurant or pub on their manufacturing plant.

“Brewpub“: Typically, a very small brewery with a restaurant where the beer it produces is sold in draft form exclusively at its own premises. This operation often sells other supplier’s bottled beer, including other hand-crafted or micro-brewed beers as well as wine to patrons for consumption on its premises. See “Special Note” below.

Type 40 – Onsale Beer

Issued to bars and taverns. Authorizes the sale of beer for consumption on or off the premises where sold. No wine or distilled spirits may be on the premises. Full meals are not required; however, sandwiches or snacks must be available. Minors are allowed on the premises. This license type is subject to Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) requirements and requires alcohol servers and managers of alcohol servers to be RBS certified.

Type 58 – Caterer’s Permit

This permit allows certain licensees to cater alcoholic beverages off-site. For further information regarding a caterer’s permit, please see our Caterer’s Permits page. This license type is subject to Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) requirements and requires alcohol servers and managers of alcohol servers to be RBS certified. Issued to bars and night clubs. Authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption on the premises where sold. Authorizes the sale of beer and wine for consumption off the premises where sold. Minors are not allowed to enter and remain (see BPC § 25663.5 for exception, musicians). Food service is not required. This license type is subject to Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) requirements and requires alcohol servers and managers of alcohol servers to be RBS certified.

Type 75 – Brewpub – Restaurant

Issued to restaurants. Authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption on a bona fide eating place plus a limited amount of brewing of beer. This license does not authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises where sold. Minors are allowed on the premises. This license type is subject to Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) requirements and requires alcohol servers and managers of alcohol servers to be RBS certified.

Choosing the Ownership Entity



When Applying for an ABC License an Entity Type is selected as the License Holder. This is typically the same ownership structure of the Business Entity looking to obtain an ABC license.

Something to consider, when selecting the Entity Type are some ABC rules.

ABC may refuse to issue a license to any person who has violated their rules in the past, has a disqualifying criminal record, or is otherwise disqualified due to any DUI's that haven't gone through a probationary period. This applies to anyone and/or their significant other who will own 10% or more of the Entity.

New Liquor License at a Previously Unlicensed Locations



When adding a new ABC license at a previously unlicensed location, the process requires additional forms to be submitted to ABC along with the complete package of application.

These Forms include

- Zoning Form- ABC 255- The applicant is required to contact the local planning dept and ask a few questions that are on the form & include the name & ph # of the person they spoke with.
- Residence Rule – ABC 247 - Write in all residential addresses within 100 Feet from the location, write in None if no nearby residential units
- Consideration Points – ABC 251 - Write in all schools, churches, hospitals, public playgrounds, and youth facilities located within 600 feet from the location. Write in None if no nearby consideration points

After submission of the application an ABC Investigator will advise if anything needs to be done. Or if it is clear to move forward at this location.

Types of License Transfers



The Transfer of an existing license is the most common way to obtain an ABC license.

The following are the types of License Transfers:



PERSON TO PERSON

Transfer of an existing license to a new owner.



PREMISES TO PREMISES

Transfer of an existing license to a new location.



DOUBLE TRANSFER

A transfer that is person to person AND premises to premises.



DROP PARTNER

One party is leaving a partnership.



STOCK TRANSFER

Transfer of 50% or more of ownership in a legal entity.



FIDUCIARY

A self-incorporation transfer between spouses, etc.

New Liquor License Authorizations



In general, many license types are readily available for purchase. Although several license types only have a certain number already allotted per County (per capita) and require Authorization from the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC).

From September 11, 2023, through September 22, 2023, in counties where such licenses are available, applications for new original on-sale general and off-sale general licenses will be accepted at district and branch offices. During the same period, priority applications will be accepted for the intercounty transfer of on-sale general and off-sale general licenses, as authorized.

Prior to the priority application period, the department will announce how many new licenses are authorized based on statutory authorizations and limitations. The department will provide a list of counties that will be eligible for additional on-sale general and off-sale general licenses.

Only one priority application will be accepted from any one applicant per county for each type of license. A fee of \$17,335 is to be paid when filing an application for a new original general license and a fee of \$6,570 is to be paid when filing a priority application for the intercounty transfer of a general license. Only a certified check, cashier's check or money order will be accepted for payment of the application fee, which should be made payable to Alcoholic Beverage Control.

If the number of applicants within a county for a particular type of license/transaction is equal to or less than the number of licenses available, all applicants will be notified that they have 90 days to complete a formal application for their specific premises.

If the department receives more applications than there are licenses available, a public drawing will be held. Priority drawings for new licenses will be scheduled the week of October 23, 2023. To participate in such a drawing, an applicant must have been a resident of California for at least 90 days prior to the date of the scheduled drawing. Successful drawing participants will be notified that they have 90 days to complete a formal application for their specific premises.

Unsuccessful drawing participants will be automatically refunded their application fee (minus a \$100 service charge) within 90-120 days of the priority drawing but will retain their priority ranking until a new priority list is established in 2023.
